

**THE GULF COAST CENTER
STATEMENT OF EMPLOYABILITY**

The Gulf Coast Center has informed me that a criminal history check will be performed on my name through the Texas Department of Public Safety and the Nurse Aide Registry & Employee Misconduct Registry. I have informed this agency of all name (i.e., maiden, aliases) that I have used in the past. I further understand that I will be barred automatically from employment with this agency if I have been found to have violated any one (1) of the penal codes listed below.

250.006 CONVICTIONS BARRING EMPLOYMENT. (a) A person for whom the facility is entitled to obtain criminal history record information may not be employed in a facility if the person has been convicted of an offense listed in this subsection:

1. An offense under Chapter 19, Penal Code (criminal homicide);
2. An offense under Chapter 20, Penal Code (kidnapping and unlawful restraint);
3. An offense under Section 21.11, Penal Code (indecent with a child);
4. An offense under Section 21.011, Penal Code (sexual assault);
5. An offense under Section 21.02, Penal Code (aggravated assault);
6. An offense under Section 21.04, Penal Code (injury to a child, elderly individual, or disabled individual)
7. An offense under Section 21.041, Penal Code (abandoning or endangering child);
8. An offense under Section 21.08, Penal Code (aiding suicide);
9. An offense under Section 25.031, Penal Code (agreement to abduct from custody);
10. An offense under Section 25.08, Penal Code (sale or purchase of a child);
11. An offense under Section 28.02, Penal Code (arson);
12. An offense under Section 29.02, Penal Code (robbery);
13. An offense under Section 29.03, Penal Code (aggravated robbery); or
14. A conviction under the laws of another state, federal law, or the Uniform Code of Military Justice of an offense containing elements of an offense listed under Subdivisions (1)-(13). (b) A person may not be employed in a position the duties of which involve direct contact with a consumer in a facility before the fifth anniversary of the date the person is convicted.

15. An offense under Section 22.01, Penal Code (assault), that is punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or as a felony;
16. An offense under Section 30.02, Penal Code (burglary);
17. An offense under Chapter 31, Penal Code (theft), that is punishable by a felony; may not be employed in a position the duties of which involve direct contact with a consumer in a facility before that fifth anniversary of the date the person is convicted.
18. An offense under Section 32.45, Penal Code (misapplication of fiduciary property or property of financial institution), that is punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or as a felony; or
19. An offense under Section 32.46, Penal Code (securing execution of a document by deception), that is punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or a felony.

I understand that all information obtained by this agency regarding my criminal history will remain confidential. I certify that the information on this form contains no willful misrepresentation and that the information given is true and complete to the best of my knowledge.
